Lesson Teaching:

Sometimes we go through hard times. Sometimes we might have to do something that feels scary. When this happens, it's natural to feel afraid, sad, or even mad. We can talk to God about how we feel and ask God to give us peace and strength to do hard things. Not Fair!

Lesson Teaching:

Sometimes we feel like something isn't fair. Maybe something bad has happened, or someone doesn't get what they deserve, or you have to share your new toy with your younger sibling. We want things to be fair. Often, we think that if something is not fair, it's a bad thing, but when it comes to God's grace, it's a good thing. *Grace* is God's kindness that we don't deserve. Throughout the Bible, we see how God gives His people grace. The greatest way we see God's grace is through what Jesus did on the cross for us. Jesus died and took away the punishment for *our* sins, even though Jesus never sinned. God demonstrates His great love for us by offering us grace, even when we don't deserve it.
